## FURTHER STUDIES

Upon completion of the program, graduates are encouraged to complete a clinical attachment to increase the safety and accuracy of their work, deepen their understanding of establishing and operating a successful aesthetic practice, and gain the confidence to independently perform various procedures on their patients. Professional Diploma graduates can apply to enrol in the Postgraduate Certificate in Cosmetic Medicine, with Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) for module 1, and upon completion of the Postgraduate Certificate may apply for credit to the Postgraduate Diploma and then continue with the MSc in Cosmetic Medicine. These postgraduate qualifications are studied online with Diploma MSc and awarded by the University of South Wales (UK).
